NECK LIPECTOMY (LIPOSUCTION) POSTOPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Rest/Sleep with head elevated 30 to 40 degrees for two (2) weeks to minimize swelling.
- 2. **DO NOT REMOVE DRESSINGS**. The dressing/tapes will remain in place until Dr. Garcia sees you at your next appointment. These provide support for the tissue and skin during the healing process.
- 3. Eat a soft diet for 2 weeks. Take medications prescribed by Dr. Garcia.
- 4. **Do Not** manipulate the dressing/tapes. If they become loose, notify Dr. Garcia and/or staff. you will be instructed on a plan of care.
- 5. Sutures/dressing/tapes will be removed at 1 week post op appointment.
- 6. Incisions behind ears:

Clean with hydrogen peroxide and Q-tips six (6) times daily, then Apply a small amount of Bacitracin ointment to the incision after each cleaning.

- 7. You may shower the morning after surgery. DO NOT SATURATE DRESSING/TAPES. If they become wet, gently pat dry.
- 8. Do not bend your head over or lift heavy objects for at least 2 weeks after surgery.
- 9. Report any undue swelling, redness, or discharge from any incision immediately.
- 10. Make sure to stand and walk around every 15 minutes.

Generally you will be scheduled for 1 day, 1 week, 2 week, 1 month, 3 month, 6 month and 1 year post-op appointments!
